At a special meeting, Wednesday, December 29th, the Cumberland County Commissioners approved the selection of three trustees to serve three year terms on the Cumberland County Civic Center board or Trustees. A swearing in ceremony will be held Friday, January 7 at the Cumberland County Courthouse.
